

Your Home Dryer

We highly recommend the homeowner to get their dryer cleaned out annually. Inside your dryer lint can stick to your heat sensor and the interior venting. When washing your clothes, if the spin cycle is not running properly it can cause the soap not to rise out of our clothes. When the clothes are drying the soap that wasn't rinsed out will stick to the lint in your dryer. When you clean your filter out the lint can be sticky. This hot sticky air can also stick to the inside heat sensor.

After a period of time the center could stop working. To prevent a service call to change out that heat sensor, we highly recommend this service; yes it may take years before the built up lint could affect your dryer's performance. Although if you have a large family you can cut that back two years. We've all seen what happens when lint builds up in a dryer, it could result in a fire. It wasn't long ago when I was in a customer's house in Waterdown Ontario; I was upstairs cleaning the carpets. The house had just been sold and the previous owner was having the carpets cleaned. I noticed an odd smell; it smelled like something was burning. I started to do some investigating, of the smell. The homeowner had left to do some running around about 20 minutes prior. Upstairs in the laundry room is where the burning smell was coming from. The washer and dryer had just been installed; the smell was coming from the dryer. It was on fire! You can just imagine my reaction; I turned the dryer off and pulled it away from the wall. The homeowner luckily just came in the front door. I yelled downstairs to him, your dryer is on fire! In a few seconds we were able to extinguish the fire. After seeing this, I understand why it is important to get your dryer's cleaned out. Even if you don't get us to do the service, put this job on your list.
